German Energy Transition

- ✓ Energy security

- ✓ Competitiveness
- ✓ Innovation
- ✓ Power grid extension
- ✓ Economic growth





Governance Challenges

- Efficient and effective risk management, avoiding postdecisional regret
- Inclusion of citizens and stakeholders ("affected parties") in decision making processes
- Implementation of public and stakeholder participation which is compatible with the legal framework





Social Acceptance Key Criteria

- Insight in beneficial change
 - O Why do we need change?
- Perceived individual and/or collective utility
 - O What is in it for me/us?
- Self-efficacy
 - O Does this limit my options?
- Identity
 - o Am I personally engaged?
